POSTING A JOB:

CO-OP PROCESS:

- · Jobs are posted for two business day and applications will be collect through ExperienceGuelph.ca
- · After the job closes, you will receive the package of applications to review
- · Select candidates to interview and contact us to coordinate interviews for you
- Should you choose to make an offer, you do so through us and the student has 48 hours to accept

CO-OP OVERVIEW:

Co-op students are available three times a year – Winter (Jan – April), Summer (May – Aug) and Fall (Sept – Dec). Some students are available to work 4,8 or 12 months. A work term is typically a minimum of 420 hours per work term and minimum of 12 weeks. Our senior co-op computing and business students are available for January – recruiting begins in September for these folks
