

## White Spruce *Picea glauca*



### Planting Tips

Mature Height: 24-30 metres

Shade: Tolerates shade.

Moisture: Tolerates a range of moisture levels.

Soil: Grows in most soil types.

## Eastern White Pine *Pinus Strobus*



### Planting Tips

Mature Height: 20 to 35 metres tall

Moisture: Tolerates different moisture levels.

Shade: Tolerates partial shade when younger

Soil: Grows in any soil type, prefers clay or sandy loam.

## Sugar Maple *Acre saccharum*



### Planting Tips

Mature Height: 35 metres

Moisture: Prefers moist soil

Shade: Can tolerate shade but grows better in full sun

Soil: Prefers deep and rich soil

## Red Maple *Acer rubrum*



### Planting Tips

Mature Height: 25 metres

Shade: Tolerates some shade.

Moisture: Grows best in moist soil, but can tolerate different moisture levels.

Soil: Grows in a variety of soils.

### Planting Tips

Mature Height: 18 m

Shade: prefers full sunlight

Moisture: adaptable to both dry and moist locations
